Military Bowling Championships

The 2016 Military Bowling Championships were recently completed at Gold Coast & Orleans Bowling Centers in Las Vegas. It was the largest event in it's 59 year long history registering 276 six person teams. 1,656 players bowled team, singles & doubles events in divisions: Active Duty, Retired or Senior Retired. The 60th annual tournament will be held at the Gold Coast Hotel, Casino & Bowling Center for the 11th consecutive year on January 15 - 21, 2017.

The tournament brings together military bowlers from worldwide assignments to participate in outstanding competition in 3 divisions - active duty/veterans, retired and senior retired. The MBC is primarily a team event with teams comprised of 6 players. Individuals can only bowl on one team. Team, Doubles and Singles are 4-game scratch events.

This is a national event and like all national events, some of our local bowlers bowled in the tournament. In the active division, Lance and Wanda Volpp participated and Lance bowled a 300 game and an 804 series in the team event. Congratulations Lance! In the retired division, Paul Rumbaugh, Don Monroe, Ron Foster, and John Heard participated. On the down side Ron Foster, and John Heard struggled and did not cash. On a better note, Don Monroe cashed in Doubles, Singles and All-Events with a 221.5 average. And then there was Paul. Paul Rumbaugh's team repeated as team all events champions! His team also placed 2nd in the team event. Paul placed 1st in singles and he finished 6th in individual all-events with a 234.5 average for 12 games.

This tournament is open to all active, retired military and federal service employees. There are separate divisions for retired and senior (over 60) retired bowlers. I invite all of the retired military and federal service employees to join me in bowling in the Military Bowling Championships next year! It will be a great time and great bowling.
