2015 – 2016 Tournament Changes!! Survey Results from the Mixed, Open, and the Youth Tournaments were reviewed and the following updates will be implemented based on the feedback that was received:

- Start time for the second shift was moved out by 1 hour later. This should help with starting the second shift on time.
- Added optional scratch team/doubles/singles events to the Mixed tournament.
- Added optional Women's HDCP A/E to the Mixed tournament.
- Added rerate rule and established criteria.
- Changed entering average from composite to the highest of the last two years.
- Added additional bracket options.

The association will discuss being prepared, lane, and staff to support the tournaments with AMF and Liberty however, this is not fully under our control.

This app is available on both ios (iPhone) and Android devices through the iTunes store, Google apps store and Samsung app store. Everyone with a smartphone or tablet should download this app.

Philip Pryor is 15 years old and is home-schooled and doing 9th/10th grade work. His mother and grandfather bowl and they dragged him along to the alley last summer. He has since joined the youth league and has made great

accomplishments. Philip earned \$480.00 in scholarship money from the Virginia State Tournament in Roanoke this year! His greatest accomplishment is that he placed first in the All Events Division! His highest game ever is a 212 and his highest set is 543, both of which were bowled at the State Tournament. He doesn't get nervous when he bowls he just tries to remember to bowl properly otherwise he has no control of the outcome. Coach Tammy has helped him the most since he has started bowling. Winning the scholarship money is a bonus to bowling; he would bowl even if there were no scholarships involved. While his bowling has improved overall, he wants to continue to work on his game as a whole in preparation for future tournaments. When asked what he likes best about bowling, he answered, "Continual progress towards a goal that is reachable through my own efforts and getting closer to beating my grandfather and mother for the weekly "King/Queen of the House" title."



Scott Southall is 14 years old. He attends Culpeper High School and is in the 9th grade. Before he started league play in September 2013, he enjoyed bowling with his family just for fun. Scott is very proud of his 8 strikes in a row
