## Survey Results

The survey distributed to all bowlers during the last few months and tournaments was created by the GFUSBC Association in attempt to identify various topics that we think you would be interested in discussing or improving. The results are below. The GFUSBCA is reviewing the results and working on the best approach to addressing and/or resolving the identified issues.

### GFUSBCA MEMBERSHIP SURVEY

1. What changes would you like to see in tournaments?
- a. Handicap increase or decrease 36% inc, 5% dec, and 59% leave as is
  - b. Lane Condition 30%
  - c. Other: Less oil, more oil, easier shot, one to one, oil between shifts. Biggest complaint 22% start on time.

2. Would you like to see other tournaments?
- a. Scratch 10%
  - b. Men Only 10%
  - c. Mixed 50%
  - d. Specific Oil Pattern (shark, cheetah, etc) Round Robin? 10%
  - e. Other women only 30%, over 50, invitational, Scotch doubles, 9 pin Tap, in league, marathon, monthly events, and midnight madness.

6. Would increase in cost of tournaments due to rising costs deter you from entering future tournaments?


