Mark is the chair for the Ways and Means committee.



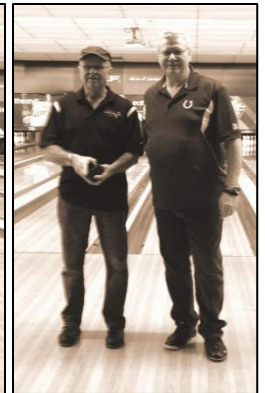
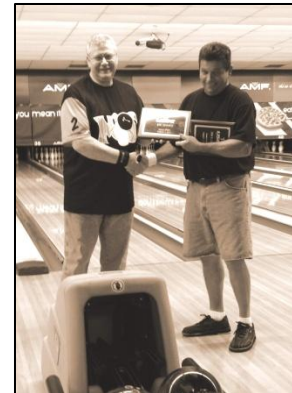

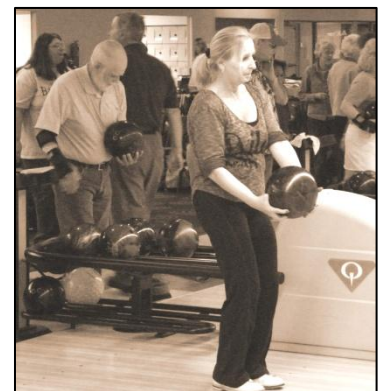
