GFUSBCA Youth/Adult Scholarship Program

The Greater Fredericksburg USBC Association will be offering a \$500 scholarship this year to 2 eligible youth bowlers to be awarded through and managed by the SMART program. All High School students are eligible. An individual is eligible to be awarded this scholarship more than once.

The Scholarship Committee will annually recognize one certified adult bowler who wishes to further their education for personal or professional enhancement. The award winner will receive a scholarship in the amount of \$500. An individual may win this award only once. Funds for the scholarship award winners will be administered through the Greater Fredericksburg USBC office.

ADULT eligible nominees must:

- Be a certified USBC member
- Be a current adult member in good standing of the Greater Fredericksburg USBC Association
- Must have participated in at least one GFUSBCA tournament in the last year
- Must already be enrolled in a degree program at an accredited college or university
- Must be maintaining a GPA of 3.0 or higher
